

Sakku's group of companies is seeking Continuum Care Workers to work at either of the GN's Elders facilities situated in Iqaluit and Arviat. Reporting to the Director of Care, the Continuum Care Worker plays a vital role in enhancing residents' quality of life at the facility. Working under the guidance of the Nurse Manager, they provide personalized care according to residents' individual care plans. This position ensures residents in need of continuing care can access necessary services within Nunavut.

## Roles & Responsibilities

- Participates in and/or organizes the delivery of therapeutic programs and social activities.
- Performs a variety of custodial tasks to maintain a safe and homelike environment for residents and their families.
- Performs specialized tasks or activities such as rehabilitative exercises and palliative care when delegated.
- Translates and interprets to facilitate dialogue between residents and professional staff.

## **Job Requirements**

- Preference will be given to graduates from a CCW Program or equivalent. (Equivalencies may include completion of first year of BScN program, LPN's or CNA's who have let their licenses lapse, etc.) Successful completion of GPA (Gentle Persuasive Approach) Course.
- Completion of Grade 8 or equivalent. (Graduation from a Continuing Care Worker Program is considered an acceptable equivalency.)
- Current CPR and First Aid certification.
- Vulnerable Sector and Criminal Record checks.

Wages range from \$30 - \$40/Hour, depending on experience. A competitive benefits package including northern and housing allowance, health package, bilingual bonus, travel benefits, RRSP, and a complete health package.
