## **Job Requirements**

- Certification in a building trade (i.e.: HVAC, Plumber, Electrician, Building Maintainer.)
- Alternatively, 3 or more years of working experience as a Maintainer; and one year
- experience working with a computerized management system.
- Demonstrated knowledge of furnaces, boilers, carpentry & electrical applications. HVAC certification is desired.
- The successful candidate must posses a valid class 5 driver's license.
- Must have good knowledge of applicable codes, including the National Building Code, National Fire Code, Plumbing code, and HVAC.
- Ability to speak Inuktitut and experience with tenants is considered an asset.
- Good time management skills are necessary, including the ability to prioritize tasks and to meet deadlines.

Starting salary is \$72,000 per annum (commensurate with experience) with a northern allowance of \$8,000 and a housing allowance of \$16,000 (based on eligibility) and a benefits package that includes an employee pension plan, group insurance and vacation travel assistance.
